Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Award, this authorization:

The Alaska Works Partnership (AWP) will provide five construction training academies for forty-two rural participants. AWP will train participants for basic employability and welder helper skills for entry-level construction jobs, including welders involved in pipeline construction occupations.

This training is for rural youth age 18-24 that have recently completed high school or dropped out of school. The training includes career activities, applied math, and skills training that lead to employment and apprenticeship opportunities. The focus will be on basic employability and welder helper skills for entry level construction jobs, including welders involved in pipeline construction occupations.

These courses will combine technical math, pre-employment skills, safety, pipe rigging, handling large metal pipe, and other technical skills for welder helpers. Participants that complete these courses will be prepared to apply to trade apprentice programs, gain entry level construction jobs, and transition to work as pipeline welder helpers in conjunction with the AWP's annual pipeline construction employment and training program.

This training provides additional skills and certifications required for work as a Pipeline Welder Helper on Alaska's North Slope.
