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A. INTRODUCTION

Throughout this Amendment these entities are referred to as follows:

Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium	=	ANTHC
Financial Assistance Sub-Award	=	FSA

On July 11, 2001, the ANTHC and the Beaver Tribal Council executed an FSA authorized by the Denali Commission to perform the planning, design, and construction of a new multi-purpose community health center. The project was funded by the Denali Commission.

B. AMENDMENT TO REVISE PROJECT BUDGET AND FUNDING SOURCES TABLE

This project was originally awarded \$154,900. This Amendment will add \$350,000 of funding, for a total award of \$504,900.

The funds are derived from Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 0100-DC-2003-I13, dated July 2003.

A revised Project Budget and Funding Sources Table is provided below.

The ANTHC is being separately funded by the Denali Commission in the amount of \$38,500 for program and professional operations expenses associated with this project. These expenses include ANTHC professional salaries, travel, and related professional support.

C. PROJECT ADMINISTRATION

The original FSA specified that the Beaver Tribal Council would manage project design and construction.

However, this Amendment changes the project administration as follows:

The Village shall assume responsibility for project design and construction management with oversight and intermittent technical assistance by the ANTHC. The local participant shall retain the services of a professional project manager, engineer, and/or contractor for the services defined in the CPA. Project design shall be completed through a competitively selected architect and engineering (A/E) contractor for design services for the provision of a primary care facility for the Village of Beaver. Project construction shall be through a Village Construction Contract.

This Agreement shall take effect upon signature by all parties and remain in effect until the expiration of the "Performance Period" specified within the Commission's Financial Assistance Award.

This document constitutes Amendment No. 1 to the FSA for the planning, design, and construction of the new Beaver Multi-Purpose Community Health Center in the Village of Beaver, Alaska. All other sections of the original FSA remain in effect as agreed upon and executed.
