



Who we are

Yuut Elitnaurviat (YE) is a non-profit, Bethel-based regional training facility partnered with ten local organizations. The mission of YE is to equip youth and adults to enter local high-skilled, high-wage jobs, or to give them the opportunity to move forward toward achieving their educational goals. Unless stated otherwise, participants who qualify for our programs **must be at least 18 and have a high school diploma, GED, or proof that they are in progress** with either of those.

What we offer

YE vocational programs cover a wide variety of career options, ranging from medical assisting professions to construction trades courses.

LOCAL OPPORTUNITIES

Specific Trades Academies

YE offers 4-week specific trades academies, covering the fields of electrical, plumbing, and carpentry. The 160 hours of training provide participants with entry-level knowledge of the trade and a national certificate verifying completion of the course through the National Center of Construction Education and Research. These courses prepare students to be laborers or to apply for Apprenticeship programs.

Apprenticeship

YE is the only vocational center in the Y-K Delta that offers a specific-trades Federally registered Apprenticeship program. Apprentices work alongside instructors and journeymen, to earn classroom and on-the-job training (OJT) hours. After completing their classroom instruction and 8,000 OJT hours, apprentices take a state licens-

ing exam to become a journeyman in the areas of carpentry, plumbing, or electrical. Applications for Apprenticeship are **only** accepted during advertised Application Drives.

Health Care

YE recognizes the vast need for medical assisting personnel. Therefore, YE offers training in Personal Care Attending (PCA), Certified Nursing Assisting (CNA), Certified Medical Assisting (CMA), and Healthcare Reimbursement. YE partners, the Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation and the Kuskokwim Campus of the University of Alaska, have joined forces to help prepare local employees for local medical assisting positions.
